International Cycle 42 FOR CANCER

On Sunday 14th September, the International Cycle 42 for Cancer celebrated for its ninth year, raising vital funds for Cancer Services across Somerset, thanks to the brilliant organisation of Iain and Ken.

The event began back in 2017, inspired by the organisers' personal experiences when both of their families were affected by cancer and received care at the Beacon Centre. Determined to give back to the NHS and support future patients, Iain and Ken launched what started as a small cycling challenge with just 60 registrations.

Nine years later, the event has grown into a truly remarkable and well-established fixture. Each year, new routes and challenges have been added, now offering 22, 42, and 62-mile cycle rides, alongside marathon and half-marathon options for runners. The event has even gone global, with participants joining from Melbourne, Vancouver, and this year, Bermuda.

Despite challenging weather, this year's turnout was outstanding: over 190 participants took part, **raising a record-breaking £20,920.25**. Combined with previous years, the event has now **raised an incredible £58,000** in total.

The atmosphere was one of camaraderie and achievement. Riders shared glowing feedback:

- "I have taken part in many events like this, but the Somerset ride was the friendliest one I've ever joined – see you next year!"
- "The event was so well organised, and we had such a brilliant day. I'm definitely feeling the aches and pains, but it was worth it for the achievement and to be part of such a great cause!"

A heartfelt thank you goes to Iain and Ken, whose tireless dedication makes this event possible, and to everyone who registered, donated, and supported so generously.

Firewalk

On Wednesday 19th November, our much-loved Charity Firewalk made a blazing return – this time hosted at Yeovil Rugby Club.

A total of 23 brave participants took on the challenge, raising vital funds for wards and departments across Yeovil Hospital, Musgrove Park Hospital, and the community.

The event was led by UK Firewalk, one of the world's leading experts in the art of firewalking. Our instructor for the evening, Scott, brought his world-class expertise (and his two Guinness World Records for the longest firewalks) to inspire our fundraisers with his "soles of steel"!

The evening kicked off as Scott led participants to the Firewalk area, where our Community and Events Fundraiser, Amy, officially ignited the flames – perfectly timed to the iconic beat of The Prodigy's "Firestarter."

As the flames roared to life, Scott led a full safety briefing, demonstrating his confidence and calm under pressure by performing a jaw-dropping stunt, snapping an arrow on his throat, sharp end first, to show that fear can be conquered with focus and trust.

With spirits high and nerves steady, our firewalkers stepped up to face the glowing coals, measuring at 637 °C! Cheered on by a lively crowd and a playlist of fiery anthems, every

participant completed the 3-metre trail – many not just once, but three or four times. True to Scott's promise, everyone finished with smiles, laughter, and even a few victory dances.

The atmosphere was electric, with supporters cheering on friends and family, creating an unforgettable sense of community and celebration.

One participant summed it up perfectly: **"That was absolutely amazing, the feeling of camaraderie between us all and achieving the firewalk, I'm so glad it did it for Yeovil Hospital"**

A huge, fiery thank you goes out to all our incredible fundraisers for their courage and enthusiasm – and to Scott and Chloe from UK Firewalk for making the evening such a success.

So far, the event has **raised an incredible £7,000**, and we're already looking forward to Firewalk 2026.
